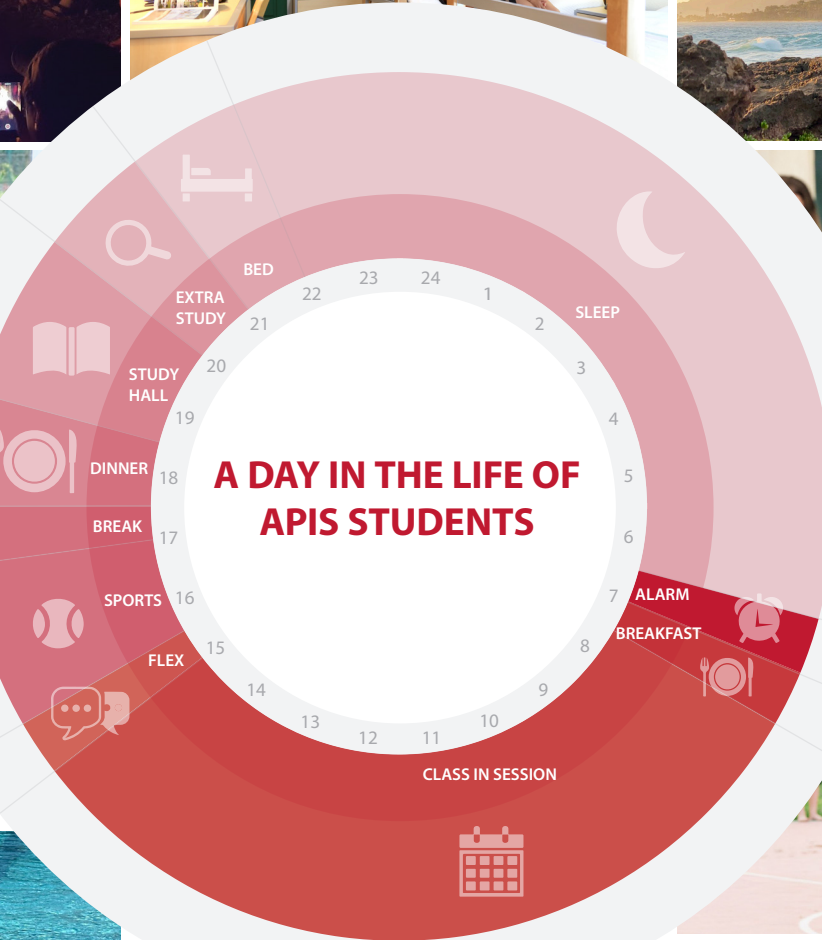


SHORT-TERM EXCEPTIONAL EDUCATION EXPERIENCE
